Shoes

- Go Math homework will not be listed on that calendar. Have your child complete one math page each night.

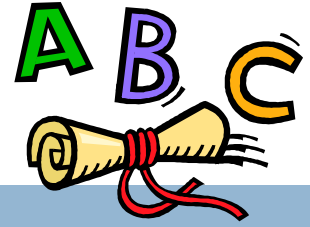


Only three hours...
